Robust Vocabulary: practice the meanings of these words with your child.

incident - An incident is something unusual that happens and often is an accident.

downpour - A downpour is a large amount of rain that falls in a short time.

seek - When you seek something you look for or try to find it.

oblivious - If you are oblivious to something, you do not see it or realize it is happening.

indecisive - When you are indecisive, you cannot make up your mind about something.
